01 February 2022 regarding approval of programmes**

The meeting of the Governing Council of the Sikkim Skill University (SSU), Namthang, Sikkim was convened and held under the Chairmanship of Dr. Bijay Singh, the Chancellor. The following persons attended the meeting:

1. At the outset, Dr. Bijay Singh welcomed all the Members in general and the State Government's Nominees in particular.
2. The Governing Council thanked the Government of Sikkim for passing the Sikkim Skill University, Sikkim Act 2021 (Act 17 of 2021) from the Sikkim Legislative Assembly in the Session of the Legislative Assembly, which received the assent of H.E. the Governor of Sikkim on 09December 2021 and which was published in the Sikkim Gazette on 16December 2021. Special vote of thanks was offered to the Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Prem Singh Tamang, the Hon'ble Education Minister Shri Kunga Nema Lepcha.
3. The Governing Council decided to sign a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Department of Health and Family Welfare, Government of Sikkim for running the District Hospital at South Sikkim under PPP mode based on the discussions held with the Hon'ble Chief Minister Shri Prem Singh Tamang and the subsequent instructions given by the Hon'ble Chief Minister to the concerned officials of the State Government.
7. The Governing Council also resolved to initiate the building work within a week at the Namthang for Classrooms and Administrative Block in at least 15000 sq.ft. with good structure duly electrified with water and other common facilities.
8. The Governing Council also thanked the KVN Skill Foundation, the Sponsoring Agency for creating an Endowment Fund of Rs. One Crore in the name of the University as per the requirements stipulated in the Act 17 of 2021 including an assurance to the State Government that this amount will not be withdrawn without the permission of the State Government and that the interest coming out of the Endowment Fund will be used for infrastructural development.
9. The Governing Council also decided to immediately inform the University Grants Commission (UGC) enclosing the Act 17 of 2021 for hosting the name of SSU as a Statutory University and adding the name of SSU in the list of recognised Universities maintain by UGC.
10. The Governing Council also resolved to collaborate with the Spices Board, India as well as the Rubber Board, India for a possible MoU for working together in order to strengthen the plantation of rubber and different types of species besides its marketing all over the world.
11. The Governing Council decided to revolutionise the vocationalisation and employment generation movement in the country in general and in the North-East in particular by co-sponsoring the birth of National Community College for Skill Development (NCCSD) with a view to introducing need based vocational and community basedprogrammes under the Community College scheme.
12. The Governing Council also resolved to make different proposals related to health, family welfare, rural and urban development, science and technology, labour and employment, industries and commerce etc. to be submitted to the Government of India and different State



Governments including the Government of Sikkim.

14. The Governing Council also decided to collect information regarding the accreditation / recognition / approval rules and regulations from the Medical Council of India, Council of Architecture, All India Council for Technical Education, National Council for Teacher Education, Bar Council of India, Indian Nursing Council, Pharmacy Council of India, Homoeopathic Council of India, Ayurvedic Council of India, Unani Council of India, Distance Education Council, Veterinary Council of India, Rehabilitation Council of India, so that applications may be submitted to these bodies in case courses covered under these councils are proposed to be launched by SSU.
15. The Governing Council decided to purchase Onevehicles immediately for positioning them at Namthang for the daily work from these areas as SSU has observed that there is a lack of such facilities in the State.
16. The Governing Council also resolved to establish the following Faculties and Departments in order to run different programmes by getting endorsement from the Academic Council of SSU. The following courses were approved to be launched :
